

EUSOBI Annual Scientific Meeting 2017

The MD/Young Resident Initiative Grant

September 22-23, 2017 | Berlin, Germany

This initiative is aimed at MD and committed residents in radiology/nuclear medicine (during their 1st or 2nd year of residency) with an interest in breast imaging and with a breast related research project (e.g. graduation thesis, doctor thesis or similar).

During the EUSOBI Annual Scientific Meeting 2017 in Berlin, Germany, the society will offer 1 MD/resident the possibility to orally present his/her breast related thesis in the plenary lecture hall of the EUSOBI Annual Scientific Meeting.

Abstracts should be submitted before **April 24, 2017, 23:59 (CET)**, via **email to the EUSOBI Office (office@eusobi.org)**.

Please note that the application to the MD/Young Resident Initiative requires also a letter of declaration and support from your supervisor.

Grant

EUSOBI is happy to cover the registration fee for the young doctor and will reimburse 2 nights of hotel accommodation up to a maximum amount of € 500,00.

Qualification criteria of the applicant

- To be a MD or a resident in radiology/nuclear medicine in the first 2 years of residency
- To be younger than 30 years at the date of the submission deadline
- To be the first author of the submitted abstract and thesis/research report
- To have submitted a signed letter of support from your supervisor (see below)

Qualification criteria of the abstract

- The abstract should summarize the results of the research, focussing on the main research question and the findings. Only thesis presented for graduation between January 2016 and April 2017 will be accepted.
- The abstract needs to be submitted by the first author

Abstract structure

Abstracts should be no longer than 300 words and be structured as follows:

Title

Provide an attractive and concise title for your work.

Purpose

Clearly describe what you intend to evaluate.

Methods

Accurately describe the essential methods employed in your research to a level that would allow repetition of the experiment.

Results

Report the obtained results in a straightforward manner. Please provide confidence intervals and measures of statistical significance when appropriate.

Conclusion

Place the results in perspective to the purpose of your study.

Summary statement

A summary statement of at most 30 words should also be provided, this should allow readers to understand the topic of the study and the most essential findings.

Rating

All abstracts will be peer reviewed by at least 2 independent reviewers. Abstracts will be scored on scientific merits, relevance to the EUSOBI audience, originality, and clarity of presentation.

The following scoring system will be used:

- 1 = Excellent
- 2 = Good
- 3 = Moderate
- 4 = Fair
- 5 = Poor

Signed declaration and letter of support from the supervisor

All abstracts/theses that are competing for the MD/Young Resident Initiative Grant need to be accompanied by a letter of support from the supervisor. The supervisor needs to be a member of the EUSOBI in good standing.

The declaration must make clear that the application criteria is met and the research has been conducted.
